TENTATIVE ITINERARY

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Experience in person the opportunity and hope your gifts make possible as you tour PWNA sites. Visit places and people where your PWNA donations are making a difference Also, enjoy awe-inspiring trips to Yellowstone National Park, Mount Rushmore, Cody, Wyoming, Little Bighorn Battlefield and much more.

Sunday, September 10 – Arrive in Billings, MT. Depending on your arrival time, the rest of the day is free to enjoy as you wish. That evening, meet staff and fellow travelers at a welcome reception and dinner.

Monday, September 11 – We will begin our tour with a trip to the distinctly western town of Cody, Wyoming, the historic home of Buffalo Bill Cody and the **Cody Museums** - the Whitney Gallery, Plains Indian Museum, Cody Firearms Museum, & the Buffalo Bill Museum. In the afternoon, we will follow the South Loop of Yellowstone National Park, where we will visit **Yellowstone Lake**, and the **Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone**. Anticipate close-up views of elk, bison, and a host of other wildlife. Evening finds us in **West Yellowstone, Montana** where we will spend the night.

Tuesday, September 12 — Today we will take in sights at **Fountain Paint Pots** and **Old Faithful Geyser** as it shoots thousands of gallons of steaming water into the air! Our tour of Yellowstone Park ends as we travel out the North entrance of the park with a stop at Mammoth Hot Springs' calcium terraces. This evening we make our way back to Billings, MT.

Wednesday, September 13 — We get an early start today and arrive at **Little Bighorn Battlefield** where Custer was defeated by the Sitting Bull. From here we head down to **Sheridan, Wyoming** for lunch and then an afternoon visit to **Devil's Tower**. We will arrive that evening in **Deadwood, SD** where you can try your luck in the casinos if you find that interesting.

Thursday, September 14 – Today, we will be visiting **Mount Rushmore**, one of the most iconic sites in the West. We will have lunch there and then head over to the **Crazy Horse Monument and Interpretive Center**. You will want to spend time in the bookstore perusing the collection of Native American themed books. From here we will travel to **Rapid City** for the night.

Friday, September 15 – We will need an early start as we head out to the site of the **Wounded Knee Massacre** in December, 1890. You will hear a first-hand account of this event from the Native American perspective, and also hear of the events that occurred in 1973, when members of the American Indian Movement occupied the town of Wounded Knee. Late afternoon will find us back at **PWNA headquarters** for a tour and farewell dinner.

Saturday, September 16 — Depart for Home.

General Terms and Conditions and Release Agreement:

1. I understand that I am responsible for exercising caution and common sense at all times to avoid injury.
2. I agree that any photo or film likenesses taken of me while on a **Global Travel Alliance** trip and any of my comments may be used in future **Global Travel Alliance** publications.
3. I hereby waive any and all claims against **Global Travel Alliance** and its agents or contractors, domestic and overseas, my local school and any staff members or chaperones accompanying the group, arising from any death, injury, loss, damage, accident, delay, irregularity, or expense to person or property incurred from the use of any vehicle or service, strikes, war, weather, sickness, quarantine, government restrictions or regulations, or arising from any act of omission of any steamship, airline, railroad, bus company, sightseeing, hotel or any other service or transporting company, firm, individual, or agency.
4. I also shall not hold **Global Travel Alliance** responsible for any loss or damage arising from any errors or omissions contained in any **Global Travel Alliance** documentation, literature, late or non-confirmation or acceptance of bookings and loss or damage caused by delays.
5. **Global Travel Alliance** shall have the right, at any time in its discretion and without liability or cost, to cancel any trip or portion of a trip, or make an alteration in itinerary, or accommodation, in the event of any trip being rendered impossible or inadvisable by weather, strikes, war, acts of God, governmental interference or **any cause whatsoever that is beyond Global Travel Alliance's control**. Any and all extra expenses that may be incurred as a result of these necessary changes will be the responsibility of the passenger.
6. I understand that **Global Travel Alliance** is not responsible for my well-being during such period of time that I may be absent from **Global Travel Alliance** supervised activities, as during free time periods, times of independent travel, visits to friends and relatives and so forth. Additionally, **Global Travel Alliance** is not responsible for my well-being once the scheduled itinerary is finished.
7. **Global Travel Alliance** is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to my belongings or to the belongings of any other person, including passports and travel documents. I understand that **Global Travel Alliance** is not responsible for the loss or theft of any of my personal property during the trip, including my airline ticket. I understand that airlines have their own procedures for dealing with lost tickets and that if I lose my airline ticket I may be required to purchase from the airline a full fare replacement ticket. I accept that it is entirely my own responsibility to pursue any refund directly from the airline.
8. In the event of an emergency requiring medical attention, I give my consent and permission to the staff of Global Travel Alliance, or attending physician to perform medical treatments and/or surgery. Global Travel Alliance cannot be held responsible for the quality and timeliness of any such medical care received, nor for any expense incurred.
9. I understand that in the event of cancellation, refunds will be given in accordance with **Global Travel Alliance's** Cancellation Policy. **(see below)** I understand that if I wish to cancel my enrollment in a Global Travel Alliance trip, I must do so in writing, by email, fax or mail.
10. I understand that I must pay my balance in full 60 days prior to departure, according to the enrollment instructions. If I fail to meet such payment deadlines, I realize that I will be required to pay a \$50 late fee and risk cancellation.
11. I understand that I am financially responsible for any damage I may cause while on trip to hotel property, bus, and any other facilities while on the trip.
12. I understand that this agreement, along with other written Global Travel Alliance documents regarding my trip, includes the entire agreement between Global Travel Alliance and me. I do not rely upon any verbal promises or agreements made to me by any employees of Global Travel Alliance, or by my school or Chaperones. Any agreements may only be modified in writing and signed by an employee of Global Travel Alliance.
13. I certify that I am in good physical and mental health and that I have no special medical or physical conditions, nor any special needs or requirements, which would prevent participation in the trip program, nor be of any harm or inconvenience to myself or the other participants. **I understand that walking long distances and climbing stairs may be required activities.**
14. If I have special dietary requirements or food allergies, I will take complete responsibility for my food intake. **Global Travel Alliance** cannot guarantee any special meal arrangements for me. I will not be compensated for any uneaten group meals.
15. This agreement becomes effective when my enrollment is accepted by **Global Travel Alliance** and I understand that this agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Montana which shall have sole jurisdiction. Additionally, I (and/or my parents or guardians if I am under the age of 21) consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and exclusive venue in the courts of Billings County, Montana., in any and all actions or proceedings related to this agreement.

Global Travel Alliance's Cancellation Policy*

- Deposits are non-refundable at anytime.
- 90-61 days prior to departure, Global Travel Alliance retains 30% of the trip cost per person (Includes deposit)
- 60-30 days prior to departure, Global Travel Alliance retains 50% of the trip cost per person (Includes deposit)
- 29 or fewer days prior to departure, Global Travel Alliance retains the entire trip cost per person. (Includes deposit)
